A Bill for an Act to amend the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** in relation to the power of school councils to employ certain staff and for other purposes.

The Parliament of Victoria enacts:

1 Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to amend the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** in relation to the power of school councils to employ certain staff.

2 Commencement

(1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.

(2) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 1 January 2021, it comes into operation on that day.

3 Employment or engagement of teachers and other staff in schools

- (1) In section 2.3.8(1) of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006**, for "A school" **substitute** "Subject to subsection (1A), a school".
- (2) After section 2.3.8(1) of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006 insert**
 - "(1A) A school council must not employ or engage a person to employ or engage another person to perform duties (other than teaching duties) at a school if those duties involve close and non-incidental interaction with students on a regular basis during normal school hours.".

4 Repeal of this Act

This Act is **repealed** on 1 January 2022.
